

# **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

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woopnews is a social news company owned by wooptech AS. Our service, with this privacy and data collection declaration, make it possible for you to express yourself in quick, entertaining ways, live in the moment, discover more and see what is happening around the world.

You create an account with a profile, and you can get 'live feed' from everyone you are following on our service, you can comment on their posts, and be a part of deciding whether it's a real or fake news story by clicking on (real news)-(fake news), and more.

We give you the opportunity to follow your favorite profiles. When you're using our service, you are sharing a certain amount of information with us. Therefore, we want to be open about the information we gather, how we are using it, who we are sharing it with, and the control we have given you, so you can access, update and delete your own information.

This is why we have written this privacy and data collection declaration. It is also the reason we have attempted to write it without too much legal jargon, which can often make these documents difficult to understand. If you still have questions regarding this privacy and data collection declaration, you can of course reach out to us.

You should read the entirety of our privacy and data collection declaration, but if you only have a few minutes, you can quickly look through part (1) and get a sense of the basic terms in just a few minutes. Some final information regarding EU countries; we in Woopnews will always try to follow all demands made by authorities, and hope that you will get in touch if you should discover any issues in regards to the new rules stated in this privacy and data collection declaration.

### Part (1)

#### Section 1. User terms

These terms regulate your use of woopnews and give information about the whoopnews service, as explained below. When you create a woopnews account or use whoopnews, you accept these terms.

Your use of the service is completely your own responsibility. Woopnews is not responsible for what you share, we will only interfere if we see and believe you are in breach of our terms and regulations or the law.

### Part (1)

#### Section 2. The woopnews-service

We agree to deliver the woopnews-service to you. The service includes all woopnews products, functions, applications, services, technologies and software that we deliver to further the goal of woopnews: to bring you closer to the people, things, and the news you like. The service contain the following elements («the service»):

- **Offer personal opportunities to create, create, connect, communicate, discover and to share.**

People are different. We want to strengthen your relationships through shared experiences that you actually care about. That is why we build systems that are trying to understand who and what you and others care about, and use that information to help you create, find, join and share experiences that are meaningful to you. Parts of this is to bring forth content, functions, offers and accounts you might be interested in, and offer ways that you can experience news, based on things you and others are doing on and outside whoopnews.

- **Further a positive, inclusive and safe environment.**

We create and use tools and offer resources to our community-members that contribute to making their experience positive and inclusive, including when we believe they might need help. We also have teams and systems working to prevent misuse and breaches of our terms and guidelines, as well as harmful and fraudulent behavior. We use all the information we have – including your information – in an attempt to keep our platform secure. We can also share information about misuse or damaging content with other woopnews partners or the police. Find out more in our guidelines for data. Under part (2) point 13.

- **Using and developing technology that help us serve our growing community in a consistent manner.**

Organizing and analyzing information for our growing community is an important part of our service. A big part of our service is to create and use groundbreaking technology that help us adjust, protect and improve our service, on a big scale, for a wide global community. Technologies like artificial intelligence and support vector machines give us the opportunity to use

complex processes in our service. Automated technologies also help us secure the functionality and integrity of our service.

- **Secure a stable, global infrastructure for our service.**

In order to be able to grow and deliver the global service we are aiming for, we have to store and transfer data across our own systems and those of our partners across the world, including outside of the country you are living in. This infrastructure can be owned or run by woopnews and third parties, or its associated companies.

- **Research and innovation.**

We use the information we have, to study our service and to collaborate with others in research to make our service better, and contribute to the welfare of our community.

## Part (1)

### Section 3. Users in the EU

If you are a user in the EU, you should know that whoopnews is owned and run by wooptech AS and is in control of your personal information along with our collaborators and the data suppliers we use for our services. Here is some additional information we want to make you aware of:

#### Use of your information

Your country permits us to use your personal information under certain conditions. These conditions are called “legal sections” and woopnews have separated them into 4 sections:

- **Contract.** One of the reasons why we can use your information is because you have consented in your agreement with us, which allows us to use parts of your information in order to give you a better experience using the service.
- **Legal interest.** Another reason we can use your information, is because we or a third-party have a legal interest to do so. For example, we need to use your information to deliver and improve our services. Including protecting your accounts, delivering your posts, giving customer support and help you find friends and content we think you will like. Something that is important to understand about legal interest is that our interests are not more important than your right to privacy, so we only trust legal interest when we believe that the way we are using it will not interfere with your private life or stray from your expectations of us, or there is another pressing reason to do so.
- **Consent.** In some instances we will ask your consent to use your information for certain purposes. If we do so, we will make sure that you can withdraw your consent in our service or through the settings. Even if we are not depending on consent to use your information, we can ask your consent to access data, such as contacts your geographical position and more.

- **Judicial obligations.** We might be made to use your personal information to comply with the law, for example when we are replying to a valid judicial process or have to take action to protect our users.

### **Your right to protest**

You have the right to protest our use of your information. We have given you the right to easily delete several types of data if you don't want us to process them for you anymore. For other types of data we have given you the opportunity to stop the use of your data by deactivating the function completely. When it comes to these and other types of information you do not want us to process, you can easily contact us to have your account deleted.

### **International transactions**

We can gather your personal information, transcribe, store and process it in USA and other countries outside of the country you are residing in. When we share information about EU users outside of the EU, for internal transfers we depend on Modell-contractual clauses in the EU-U.S. and Swiss-U.S. privacy shield, which you can read more about on <https://www.privacyshield.gov/list>

## **Part (1)**

### **Section 4. Your obligations**

In return for our obligation to deliver the service, we demand that you commit and will be accountable to us in regard to the following.

**Who can use woopnews.** We want our service to be as open and inclusive as possible, we also want it to be safe, secure and to comply with the law. We therefore need you to commit to certain restrictions in order to be a part of the woopnews-community.

- You have to be at least 13 years of age.
- You cannot be restricted from receiving any aspect of our service in accordance with the applicable laws. You cannot participate in payment-related services if you have been put on a list of people who are denied access.
- You cannot participate if we have previously deactivated your account due to legal breaches or breaches of any of our guidelines.

- You cannot be a convicted sexual offender or have been convicted for other serious legal breaches.
- **How you are not allowed to use woopnews.** In order to offer safe and secure service to a wide community we demand that everyone take their part.
- **You cannot pretend to be someone else or submit false information.** You don't have to expose your identity on woopnews, but you have to give us correct and updated information (including registration information). You are not allowed to pretend to be someone you are not, and cannot create an account for someone else unless you have their explicit consent.
- **You're not allowed to do anything illegal, misleading or dishonest or for an illegal or unauthorized purpose.**
- **You cannot breach (or help someone else breach) these terms or our guidelines.**
- **You cannot do anything to disturb or weaken the intended operation of the service.**
- **You cannot attempt to create accounts or get access to or gather information in unauthorized ways.**  
This includes creating accounts or gather information in an automatic manner without our explicit consent.
- **You cannot attempt to purchase, sell or transfer any aspect of your account (including your user name) or ask for, gather or use other users log-in information or images.**
- **You cannot publish private or confidential information or do anything in breach with other peoples' rights, including material rights.**
- **You cannot use domain names or a URL-address in your user name without our explicit consent.**
- **You can only share videos or images you have taken or recorded or have received permission to share.**
- **You own the content you publish on woopnews.**
- **You have to remember to publish authentic content, and not publish anything you have copied or found online without having permission to publish it.**
- **You can never publish pornographic or abusive content, you cannot use the service to bully others or publish material that is harmful or upsetting to others.**

**Permissions you give us.** As a part of this agreement you give us the permission we need to deliver the service as fault-less as possible, which means that if you commit a breach of our terms and guidelines we can suspend or delete your account immediately.

- **We don't take ownership of your content, but you give us license to use it.**

We don't demand ownership of content you publish on or through the service. Instead, when you share, publish or upload content that is protected by non-material guidelines (such as photographs or images), or in association with our service, you give us a non-exclusive, royalty free, transferable, license transferrable, world-wide license to run, use, distribute, modify, purchase, copy, perform or publicly display, translate and make derivative work from your content (in accordance with your privacy and application settings). You can terminate this license at any time by deleting your content or your account. However, your content will still be visible if you have shared with others who have not deleted it.

- **Permission to use your username, profile picture and information about your actions and connections, along with accounts, ads and sponsored content.**

You give us permission to show your username, profile picture and information about your actions (for example likes) along with or in association with accounts, ads, offers and other sponsored content that you follow and engage with. We can for example show that you have liked a sponsored post created by a brand that has paid us to show their ads on whoopnews. As with interaction with other content and followers of other accounts, interactions with sponsored content and follows of sponsored accounts will only be seen by people that have permission to see or follow that content.

## **Part (1)**

### **Section 5. Further rights we retain**

- If you choose a username or an equivalent identification for your account, we can change it if we find it to be purposeful or necessary (for example if it is in breach of someone's non-material rights or is pretending to be another user)
- If you use content that is protected by non-material rights we have and make available in our service (for example image, design, video or sound we deliver, and that you insert into content you create or share) we retain all rights to our content (but not yours).
- You can only use our non-material rights and brands (or similar brands) with written permission from us.
- You must have written permission from us or be under a license for open source code to edit, make derivative work from, disassemble or in any other manner attempt to extract source code from us.



## **Part (1)**

### **Section 6. Removal of content and deactivation or termination of your account**

- We can remove content or information you share on the service, if we believe it is in breach of these terms or our guidelines (including the guidelines for the woopnews-community), or if we are obliged to do so by law. We can refuse to deliver or stop delivering all or parts of the service to you (including terminating or deactivating your account) immediately if you clearly, seriously or repeatedly break the rules laid out in the terms or guidelines, including the guidelines for the woopnews-community, if you repeatedly disregard the non-material rights of others, or where we are obliged to do so by law. If we take measure to remove your content due to a breach of our guidelines for the community, deactivate or terminates your account, we will notify you as necessary. If you believe your account has been terminated by a mistake, or you want to deactivate or permanently delete your account, you can easily get in touch via email.
- Content you remove can remain on the service for a limited time period and will still be visible where others have shared it. This section, and the one below named “Our agreement and what happens if we disagree”, will still be valid even after the account is terminated or deleted.

## **Part (1)**

### **Section 7. Our agreement and what happens if we disagree**

#### **Our agreement.**

- Your use of our API falls under our guidelines for the platform. If you use other functions or related services, you will be given the opportunity to accept additional condition that will then be included in our agreement. If you for example use payment functions, you will be asked to accept payment conditions for the community. If any of these conditions should turn out to be in conflict with the agreement, these other conditions will override the agreement.
- If any aspect of this agreement cannot be enforced, the rest of the agreement will still remain valid.
- All disclaimers or changes or to our agreement must be in writing and signed by us. If we should choose not to enforce any part of this agreement, this cannot be seen as a disclaimer.
- We retain all rights we have not explicitly handed over to you.

- **Who has right in accordance with this agreement**

- This agreement does not give rights to any third parties.
- You cannot transfer your rights or obligations in this agreement without our consent.
- Our rights and obligations and responsibilities can be transferred to others. This could for example happen if there are changes to the ownership of our company (for example by fusion, purchase or sale of assets) or through the law.

### **Who is responsible if anything should happen**

- We are taking reasonable precautions and diligence when delivering the service to you in regards to keeping a safe, secure and faultless community, but we cannot guarantee that the service will always function without disruptions, delays or mistakes. Given that we, to a reasonable degree, have acted with competence and due diligence, we don't accept any responsibility for: loss not caused by our breach of these guidelines or in any other way is caused by our actions; loss that could not reasonably have been predicted by you and us at the time these terms were created; harmful; indecent, obscene, illegal or in any other way objectionable content published by others, that you can come across in our service; and events that are beyond our reasonable control.
- The above neither excludes nor limits our responsibility for deaths, bodily harm or faulty representation caused by our negligence. It does not exclude or limit or responsibility in regards to other circumstances where the law forbids us to do so.

### **How we deal with disputes.**

If you are a user and residing in a EU-member state, the laws in the country of your residence are applicable for all claims, lawsuits or disputes you have against us that arise as a consequence of or in relation to these terms ("demands"), and you can pursue the claim in any competent court where the member state has jurisdiction over the claim. In any other event you accept that the claim must be processed by a competent court in Norway, and that it is Norwegian law that will be applicable for these conditions and any claims, with no regards to decisions about legal conflicts.

## **Unsolicited material.**

We always appreciate feedback or other suggestions, but can use them without limits or compensation to you, and are not obliged to keep them confidential.

## **Part (1) Section 8. Children**

### **Children**

Our service is not aimed at – or meant for – children under the age of 13 years. In addition we can limit how we collect, use and store some of the information about EU-users aged between 13 and 16 years. In some cases, this means that certain functions cannot be offered to these users. If we have to rely on consent as a legal basis to process your information and your country demands consent from a parent or guardian, we have to demand this consent before we gather and use that information.

## **Part (1) Section 9. Updating these terms**

We can change our service and guidelines, and might have to make changes to these terms to ensure that they accurately reflect our service and guidelines. If nothing else is legally required, we will alert you (for example through our service) at least 30 days ahead of changes to these terms, and give you an opportunity to look through them before they are enacted. If you continue to use the service, you will be bound by the updated terms. If you do not wish to accept these or any of the updated terms, you can delete your account by sending us an email.

### Part (2)

#### Section 10. The type of information we gather

There are three basic types of information we gather:

- **Information you choose to give us.**
- **Information we receive when you are using our service.**
- **Information we receive from third parties.**

#### **Information you choose to give us**

When you use our service, we collect information that you choose to share with us. For example, our first demand is that you create a basic woopnews-account. In relation to this we have to collect some important details about you, such as the username you want to use, a password, an email address. We need this information in order to give you access to our service. You will, of course, also give us access to all information you share through our service. Remember that the reasonable precautions you should take when using the internet also applies to woopnews; don't share posts, messages or content you don't want anyone to save or keep sharing.

We assume that you understand this, but will still say it; when you get in touch with customer service or communicate with us in other ways, we will gather the information you are sharing voluntarily.

- **Information we receive when you are using our services**
- When you are using our services, we gather information about your use, and how you have used them. We can for example know that you, on a certain Story, looked at a certain news story for a certain period of time and commented on it to friends or others. Here is a more thorough explanation about the types of information we gather when you use our services:
- **Information about use.** We gather information about you through our services. We can for example gather information about:
  - How you interact with our service, for example which hash tags you're looking at or are using on woopnews, which Stories you are looking at, or which search words you write in.
  - How you communicate with others, like their names, time and date for the communication, the number of messages you exchange with friends, family or others, who you are sending the most messages with and how you interact with messages (for example when you open a message or take a screenshot).

- **Information about units.** We gather information from and about the units you are using. For example we will gather:
  - information about your software and hardware, like unit model, operating system, unit storage, ad-identifications, different application identifications, installed apps, different unit identifications, kind of web browser, language, battery level and time zone;
  - information from unit sensors, such as accelerometers, gyroscopes, compasses, microphones, and if you have headphones connected; and
  - information about wireless and mobile network connections, for example cell phone number, service provider and signal strength.
- **The Unit's Contact List.** Because woopnews is about communication, we can at times, with your permission – gather information from the list of contacts on your unit.
- **Camera and images.** Our service requires access to the unit's camera and images. For example you will not be able to upload images from your photo library unless we have access to the camera or images.
- **Localization information.** When you are using our services, we can gather information about your location. With your consent we can also gather information about precise through of methods that include GPS, wireless networks, cell phone towers, Wi-Fi access points and other sensors, such as gyroscopes, accelerometers and compass.
- **Information gathered by information capsules and other technology.** As with most electronic services and cell phone applications, we can use information capsules and other technology, for example web signals, web storage and different commercial identifications to gather information about activity, web browser and units. Most web browsers are set to automatically accept information capsules. If you prefer it, you can usually remove or reject information capsules through the settings on your web browser or unit. However, remember that if you remove or reject information capsules, it can affect the accessibility and functionality of our services.
  - **Login information.** We also gather login information when you are using our services. Among other things, this information include:
    - details about how you have used our services
    - unit information such as web browser and language
    - times of access
    - web pages you have seen
    - IP-address
    - identifiers associated with information capsules or other technology that can identify your unit or web browser.

- pages you visited before or after you navigated onto our webpage

### **Information we gather from third parties**

We can gather information about you that other users give out when they are using our services. For example, if another user allow us to gather information from the list of contacts on their unit – and you are one of this user's contacts – we can combine information we gather from this user's list of contacts with other information we have gathered about you. We can receive information from the companies we collaborate with and third parties. Here you have a few examples:

- advertisers can give the information to us, if you have installed a new app or game so that we can decide if we showed you and ad for it.
- if you interact with one of our partners, they can share information with us to help us guide or master the performance of the service.

### **How we use information**

The short version is: give you fantastic products and services that we are always improving. Here are some of the ways we can do this:

- Develop, service, serve, improve, deliver, maintain and protect our products and services.
- To communicate with you, including through email. We can for example use email to reply to your support-inquiries or to share information about our products, services and campaign offers we think are of interest to you.
- Monitor and analyze trends and usage.
- Tailor-make our services by, among other things, suggesting friends or profile information, or customize the content we are showing to you, including ads.
- Contextualize your experience by, among other things, labeling Memory – content by the help of precise information about location (of course, only if you have given us permission to gather this information) and attach other labels based on the content.
- Deliver and improve the ad's targets and measurements, including by use of your precise location information (again, only if you have given us permission to gather this information), both in and outside of our services.
- Improve the safety of our products and services.
- Verify your identity and prevent fraud or other unauthorized or illegal activity.
- Use information that we have gathered from information schedules or other technology, to improve our services and your experience of them.
- Enforce our terms for the service and other guidelines for use.

## Part (2)

### Section 11. How we use the information

#### **Deliver, adjust and improve our products.**

We use the information we have to deliver our products, including to adjust functions and content, including news updates, and to give you suggestions such as news or events you might be interested in, or topics you might want to follow. To make personalized products that are unique and relevant to you, we use your connections, preferences, interests, activities, based on data we gather and have learned from you and others, including potential data with special protection you choose to give out, when you have given your explicit consent, how you use and interact with our products, and persons, places or things you are connected to and interested in on and outside of our products. Learn more about how we use information about you to adjust functions, content and recommendations on your woopnews-experience, including functions, content and recommendations in woopnews

- **Information on woopnews and units:** we connect information about your activities on woopnews and units deliver a more tailored and consistent experience on the woopnews-product you are using, regardless of where you are using them. We can for example suggest that you join a news discussion made up of people you are following on woopnews or what you have previously shared.
- **Location related information:** We use location related information, such as you location, where you live, where you like to go, and the companies and people you are close to, to deliver adjust and improve our products, including future ads, for you and others. Location related information can be based on, among others, precise position of the unit (if you have given us approvals to collect it), IP addresses and information from you.
- **Product research and development:** we use the information we have, to develop, test and improve our products, including by doing surveys and research, and to test and debug new products and functions.
- **Ads and other sponsored content for the future:** we want to use information we have about you, including information about your interests, actions and connections, to choose and adjust ads offers another sponsor material that we show you.

**Furthering safety, integrity and security.**

We use the information we have, to verify accounts and activities, prevent harmful behavior, discover and prevent spam and other unpleasant experiences, to keep the integrity of our products and further safety and security on and outside of woopnews. For example, we use data we have to investigate suspicious activity or breaches of our terms or guidelines, or to discover when somebody needs help

**Communication with you.**

We used information we have, to send you marketing materials, communicate with you about our products and tell you about our conditions and guidelines. We also use your information to answer you when you contact us.

**Research and innovation with social benefit.**

We use the information we have two support and execute research and innovation on topics such as general social welfare, technological innovation, public interest, health and welfare.

**Part (2)****Section 12. How information is shared****People and accounts you share and communicate with**

When you share and communicate through our product, you're choosing a public audience for what you are sharing. When you for example publish a post on woopnews, it will appear on the top of the newsfeed. Your network can also see your actions on the service, as long as it is not something you have shared anonymously.

**Content others share or re-post about you**

You should consider what you choose to share, because people that can see your activity on our product, can also choose to share it with others on and outside of our product, including people and companies outside of the intended audience. When you for example share a post or send a comments to a specific post or account, they can download or take screenshots all of and the content to others on or outside of our product, when you comment on someone else's post or react to their content, your comments or reaction is visible for everyone who can see the other person's content.

People can also use our product to create and share content about you with an audience they choose. People can for example share an image of you in a story, mention or tag you at a place in a post, or share information about you in their posts or messages. If you are uncomfortable with what others have shared about you on our product, you can report the post, ask the user to remove it or get in touch with us.



**Information about your active status or presence on our products.**

People in your networks can see signals that tell them if you are active on our product.

**Apps, webpages, and third party integrations on or with the use of our products.**

When you choose to use a third-party app, web browser or other services that uses, or are integrated with, our product, they can receive information about what you publish or share.

**New owner.**

If the shareholding company that control all or part of our products or their assets change, we can transfer your information to the new owner.

**Sharing with third parties**

We collaborate with third parties that are helping us to deliver and improve our products, we don't sell any of your information to anyone, and will never do it either. We also keep strict restrictions on how our partners can use and present the data we present them with.

**Law enforcement or judicial requests**

We share information with the police or as a response to judicial requests in the events where this is necessary.

**Part (2)****Section 13. What are our legal grounds for processing data**

We gather, use and share the data we have, in the ways described above

- to fulfill our woopnews conditions
  - in accordance with your consent, that you can withdraw at any time by contacting us on email
  - as necessary to comply with our legal obligations
  - to maintain your vital interests, or the vital interests of others
  - as necessary for public interest
- as necessary for our (or others) legitimate interests, including our interest to deliver an innovative, personally customized, safe and profitable service to our users and partners, unless these interests are overridden by your interests or basic rights and freedom which require protection of personal information.

## **Part (2)**

### **Section 14. Executing your rights to the General Data Protection Regulation**

In accordance with the general data protection regulation you have the right to access, edit, transfer and delete your data. You also have the right to complain about and limit certain forms of usage of your data. This include

- the right to complain about our usage of your data
- the right to complain about our usage of your data when we are executing a task the public interest or pursuing a third party's legitimate interests.

## **Part (2)**

### **Section 15. Preservation of data, deactivation and deletion of an account**

We store data until it's no longer necessary in order to deliver our services or until your account is deleted, whichever comes first. This is decided on a case by case basis, and will, among other things, depend upon the type of data, why it was gathered and managed, and relevant judicial or operational preservation needs.

When you delete your account, we delete the things you published, such as images and other information, and you will not be able to retrieve this information at a later time. Information that others have shared about you, but which isn't a part of your account will not be deleted. If you don't want to delete your account, but want to temporarily stop using our product you have the full freedom to do so, we will not delete your account unless you ask us to or if we are forced to do so for other reasons.

## **Part (2)**

### **Section 16. How we respond to judicial requests or prevent damage**

We can access, store and share your information with regulating authorities, the police or others:

- As a response to a judicial request, if we in good faith believe that the law requires us to do so. We can also respond to judicial requests when we in good faith believe that the response is required by law in the respective jurisdiction, concerns users in the jurisdiction and is in accordance with internationally recognized standards.
- When we in good faith believe that it is necessary to discover, prevent and address fraud, unauthorized use of product, breaches to our conditions or guidelines, or other harmful or illegal activity to protect ourselves including our rights, our property or our products, you or others, including as a part of surveys or requests from regulating authorities; or to prevent deaths or risk of bodily harm. If it is relevant, we give information to and receive information from a third party about the reliability of your account to prevent fraud, misuse or other harmful activity on and outside of our products.

The information we receive about you can be accessed and kept over a longer period when it is the subject of a judicial request or obligation, a state inquiry or investigations into possible breaches on our terms and guidelines, or in another way to prevent damage. We also retain information from accounts that have been deactivated due to breach of our terms for at least one year in order to prevent repeated misuse or other breaches of the terms.

### **Section 17. How we will notify you about changes to these guidelines**

We notify you before making changes to these guidelines and give you the opportunity to go through the revised guidelines before you choose if you want to continue using our products.

## **Part (2)**

### **Section 18. End-User License Agreement (EULA) of WoopNews**

This End-User License Agreement ("EULA") is a legal agreement between you and WoopTech AS

This EULA agreement governs your acquisition and use of our WoopNews software ("Software") directly from WoopTech AS or indirectly through a WoopTech AS authorized reseller or distributor (a "Reseller").

Please read this EULA agreement carefully before completing the installation process and using the WoopNews software. It provides a license to use the WoopNews software and contains warranty information and liability disclaimers.
